



YHKCC TALENTED SCHEME

FORM 1 ADMISSION PROCEDURES (2026 – 2027)

Every year the YHKCC sets aside some school places for students with outstanding achievements in specific areas and there is an “alternative track” admission procedure for applicants with special talents. Scholarships are also available for some successful applicants. It is expected that all students admitted to the school through this scheme will continue to actively participate in whichever area they have special talents for at least three years, e.g. excellent football players will join the school football team.

I. Scholarship

Successful applicants may be granted a full scholarship or a partial scholarship for two school years. If students on scholarships are able to maintain an outstanding level of achievement by the end of Form 2, a scholarship will also be granted for the following school year. (NB. Scholarship decisions are made at the discretion of the school.)

II. Application Notes

1. All students who apply through the Talented Scheme must also satisfy the school’s minimum academic and behavioural expectations, including a conduct grade (or comments about the student’s conduct) of B+/good or better on the Primary 5 report card.
2. Shortlisted applicants for Category I – Strong Academic Background are not required to go through the normal admission procedures. Instead, students are invited to attend an interview with the Principal directly. Parents are notified about the admission status soon after the interview.
3. Shortlisted applicants for Category II – Additional Talents will be invited to attend an assessment additionally and go through the normal admission procedures.

4. The YHKCC welcomes recommendations from the Principal and/or teachers of the primary school for applicants with outstanding talents in Sports, Music, Drama and Visual Arts.
5. Students who are admitted to the school through the Talented Scheme are still required to take internal academic assessments in English, Chinese and Mathematics. If their performance in these assessments is not up to the school's required standard, the YHKCC will provide additional support and students must attend an after school academic enhancement programme. In this case, students can only join one extra-curricular activity in Sports, Music, Drama and Visual Arts.
6. Applicants who can satisfy the criteria listed in Appendix 1 are eligible to apply for the Talented Scheme. The admission interview and assessment are considered for special admission to the YHKCC through the Talented Scheme. Please note that the school will **not** consider or process applications which cannot provide the required supporting evidence or satisfy the criteria.
7. Unsuccessful applicants are placed into the main round for admission for the school's further consideration.

The two categories for applications through the Talented Scheme are shown in the table below.

Applicants who have excellent performance in English, Chinese and Mathematics (i.e. A/90 marks or above) and a conduct grade (or comments about the student's conduct) of B+/good or better on the Primary 5 report card will be granted an interview with the Principal directly. Successful applicants may be awarded a full scholarship for the first two years of study (i.e. Forms 1 and 2) in the YHKCC. The decision will be made at the discretion of the school. If students with full scholarships achieve a top five ranking on the second semester report card in Form 2, a full scholarship will also be granted for the following school year. Primary school report cards from the past two years will be used as one of the criteria to assess applicants. No additional documents are required.	The specific areas include: 1. Sports (Athletics, Basketball, Football, Rugby, Swimming and other sports) 2. Music 3. Drama 4. Visual Arts Please refer to <i>Appendix 1</i> for the criteria and documents and/or videos that need to be submitted. Please note that applicants are required to submit these documents before the application deadline and will therefore need to get them ready beforehand. Successful applicants may be awarded a full scholarship for the first two years of study (i.e. Forms 1 and 2) in the YHKCC. The decision will be made at the discretion of the school. If students with full scholarships achieve outstanding awards in Hong Kong or in international competitions up to Form 2, a full scholarship will also be granted for the following school year.

The video can be uploaded to an online platform (e.g. YouTube, Vimeo, etc.). Share the URL in the online application form. Remark: Only shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend an assessment by sports team teachers/coaches.	1. A <u>combined file</u>* including the qualifications attained and/or any certificates or images of medals/trophies for the best 5 awards in any competitions in the past two years. 2. A <u>video</u>* (max. 5 minutes) with the performance of choir/orchestra/band or a particular musical instrument(s) should be uploaded to an online platform (e.g. YouTube, Vimeo, etc.). Share the URL in the online application form.

The combined file can also include artwork and certificates or images of medals/trophies for the best 5 awards in any competitions. - An <u>optional video</u> (max. 3 minutes) with 3D making skills can be uploaded to an online platform (e.g. YouTube, Vimeo, etc.). Share the URL in the online application form.
